Welcome to our introduction of Studley Royal Cricket Club. It may be that you are already a Member, Player, Sponsor or friend of the Club, in which case thank you and welcome to 2009, however if this is a fresh contact please allow us to introduce you to our Club.

In these very difficult financial times we are delighted that our three major sponsors have again agreed to support us in 2009. AMG Leisure, Ripon Interiors and Ripon Timber will again support the York Senior League team, The Nidderdale League teams, and The Junior section respectively.

Many other opportunities however still exist for new sponsors, with a particular need this year for help on our very successful Twenty20 days. So please read on and see the various opportunities available and we hope you decide to support Studley Royal Cricket Club.

2008 again saw a continuation of the progress of Studley Royal both on and off the field of play. Under the new Captaincy of Steve Walmsley the First Team had to battle all season against relegation, but a much improved second half to the season ensured that they finished one place higher, 8th place, in the league than in 2007. The Second Team sadly lost their Division 2 status, but their were some fine displays by younger players in the side, and a quick return from Division 3 under the captaincy of Richard Grime is anticipated. The Third, Fourth and Evening League teams all had good respectable seasons.

2009 will again see us field over 20 teams at various age groups and in various leagues, both indoor and outdoor. In 2009 we will again be fielding 4 Senior teams on a Saturday, one in the York Senior League and three in the Nidderdale League. This is the fifth season we have fielded four Saturday teams, and this has been done to provide cricket for the large Junior section that has been operating now for many years. We will also play one senior team in the Harrogate and District Evening League Division One.

The Junior section will again field teams at Under 9,11,13,15 and 17 levels, playing in the Nidderdale Junior League. We provide the largest number of teams from any Club in the Nidderdale League. Our Under 15's won the Bob Mellor Cup, while the Under 13's won the League Play Off Final, and we won the League and the Cup at Under 11 for the second year running.

12 weeks of winter training and Indoor League cricket for 7 junior teams is in addition to the summer Monday Night coaching we provide for our Young Tykes from 5 years of age. Several players have progressed in recent years through our Junior section and played Representative League cricket as well as representing North Yorkshire and Yorkshire at Under 11,13, 15, 16 and 19 levels.

The Studley Royal Academy has again commenced in 2008/09. This saw 24 invited players between the ages of 11 to 15 being coached, under the guidance of former Yorkshire Pathway To Excellence Director of Cricket, Andy Mackle and ECB Level 2 Coach Steve Walmsley.



The Academy was operated along the same lines as Andy used for the Yorkshire School of Excellence, and highlighted the wealth of talent at the Club and this is another step forward as the Club continue the youth development which is so important, not only for our Club but also for the entire local community.

We continue to be proud of our ClubMark accreditation, and we will now build on this as a Club, as we work together with The Yorkshire Cricket Board Harrogate Development Group.

Hosting the 20/20 competitions will continue this year along with all the many other events during the course of the year which we Host, like Yorkshire Under 15's and League Representative Matches.

We will never rest on our laurels, and in 2009 we will continue to improve playing standards, facilities, and equipment with the help of our energetic team of supporters. Indeed further ground development is high on the Club agenda and substantial costs are being incurred on ground improvement, including major drainage expenditure.

The above is intended to give you a flavour of the activities at this vibrant and flourishing cricket club.
